Asked for "pre-game" conference.</li> <li>➤ Exhibited professional and respectful demeanor and attitude.</li> <li>➤ Dress appearance (Business Dress or at minimum Business Casual Dress).</li> <li>➤ Has a working grasp and solid comprehension of the RULE BOOK.</li> <li>➤ Applies the RULES in accordance with IAABO and Interpretation guidelines.</li> </ul>

Mechanics		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Uses only illustrated IAABO mechanics.</li> <li>➤ Clearly communicates to partner, coaches, players, and table.</li> <li>➤ Table communications are from the IAABO reporting area.</li> <li>➤ Did not make preliminary signals if not the primary official</li> <li>➤ Strong, sharp whistle.
